Abstract

‘The Long Viking Age’ – a research perspective on the Late Iron Age

In 2022, the Centre for Viking Age Studies was established at Museum Southeast Denmark. The focus is the Viking Age proper, but the perspective is ‘the Long Viking Age’ including the time span of the Norse mythology present at least from the 5th century and vital until the 11th century AD, thus being the religious and ideological root for the lives of most of the people in Scandinavia for a good deal of the 1st Millennium AD. The aim of the Centre for Viking Age Studies is to scrutinize this long-term perspective and publish research articles and books, but it is almost as important to invite both scholars and lay people to discuss all kinds of aspects of ‘the Long Viking Age’.
